General Supplies for CWS' Emergency Shelter:

**Non-perishable food:** Cake mixes, cans of frosting, canned meals (stew, chili, soup, etc.), curry chille powder, flour, boxed dinners, boxed items(dry cereal, oatmeal, potato or rice dishes, hamburger helper, macaroni and cheese etc.), peanut butter, sugar, oil, canned vegetables and fruits, canned tuna or chicken, tea, coffee, condiments, spices, microwavable dinners, rice noodles, rice , dried beans, masa, dried chilies fish sauce, soy, rice vinegar, ramen noodles.

**Paper goods and cleaning products:** Toilet paper, paper towels, tissues, disinfecting wipes, sponges, laundry soap, cleaning gloves, dishwasher soap, dish soap, hand soap, Windex, 409 multipurpose spray, and SOS pads.
